

WHO CAN HAVE INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL INSURANCE?



YOU CAN HAVE INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL INSURANCE:

- if you are a German citizen.
- if you have lived in Germany for more than 6 months.



HOW MUCH DOES INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL INSURANCE COST?

For **one person**, international travel insurance costs:

- 12 euros for people up to the age of 64.
- 30 euros for people aged 65 or over.

For **families**, international travel insurance costs:

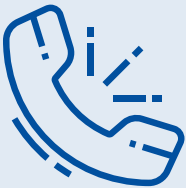
- 30 euros for people up to the age of 64.
- 75 euros for people aged 65 or over.





WHAT DOES INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL INSURANCE PAY FOR? INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL INSURANCE PAYS OUT:

- for accidents when travelling abroad,
- for illnesses when travelling abroad,
- for treatment by a doctor or a dentist abroad,
- for treatment by a doctor or a dentist in a hospital,
- for medicines and dressings,
- for treatment if infected with coronavirus,
- for medical repatriation,
 - if you are very ill,
 - if you have to come back to Germany straight away due to illness,
 - if you have to go to a German hospital.
- treatments such as physiotherapy or massages,
- aids such as wheelchairs,
- search and rescue,
- a funeral abroad,
- transport to Germany for a person who has died,
